## Helpful tips! Guide to Japanese manners

**At a restaurant ...**  
Order food for the number of people!  
Please order food for the number of people in your group at a restaurant (as well as at a ramen shop or sushi bar). If the menu says "minimum order of 2 portions", you can also share the dish with others in your party. At a restaurant serving alcoholic beverages, you can order several dishes and share them all. At this kind of restaurant, "otoshi", a small appetizer served automatically with your first drink, and cover charge (small amount) will be added to the bill.

**At a hotel buffet ...**  
Take as much food as you can eat and finish them all!  
Many hotels offer buffet-style breakfast or dinner. Take the food items of your choice on your plate and have a seat at a buffet. Use the serving utensils (chopsticks, knife, fork etc.) provided for each item when you help yourself. Take smaller portions and do not fill your plate with lots of food at once. You can return to the buffet station as often as you like. Overloading your plate or taking more food items than necessary are considered as bad manners.

**Wait in line!**  
If there is a line, join the end of the line and wait your turn!  
People may wait in line in front of the entrance of many facilities, fareboxes on buses or ticket gates at train stations to present or insert their ticket. It is said that Japanese people love to wait in line. Actually you will see a very long line of people waiting in front of a popular restaurant or shop. You cannot cut in line instead of waiting in line. People line up quietly and wait their turn in Japan.

**Must try! Classic delicacies of Okinawa**

**Awamori**  
A distilled spirit produced in Okinawa. This is a delicious spirit allowing you to enjoy rich aromas and full-bodied flavor. Brewed 100% naturally, it is less likely to give you a hangover the next day as well. The aging gives awamori rich and mild flavor and scent that are distinctive to aged sake. Having no expiration date, it is also ideal as a souvenir!

**Okinawa Soba**  
"Okinawa Soba" is a traditional noodle dish in Okinawa and known as a popular specialty loved by locals in Okinawa. The noodles are made from 100% wheat flour and taste different than Japanese buckwheat noodles. There are various kinds of "Okinawa Soba", the taste and ingredients of which vary from restaurant to restaurant. There are many renowned restaurants of Okinawa Soba in the north of Okinawa, so compare the taste!
